What: OFMC Jr. Music Festival

When: Saturday, March 24, 2012

The registration information is at the end of this newsletter. Please fill it out and return it with me along with payment of \$15 per student. If you are writing a check, please make checks payable to Angie Vaubel. Students participating in festival perform two pieces from memory for two judges (no parents, no teachers, no audience allowed in the room.)

Here's the timeline of goals for my students as we approach March 24 (Put this timeline in a handy place for the students to see!):

January: Have festival music chosen. Listen to recordings. Study music. Learn hands separately, then together. By end of month, both pieces hands together with music observing all musical details (use FRIENDS chart)

February: Work up to tempo with music, drill tricky sections until they flow smoothly. By end of month, both pieces memorized (this includes all musical details (use FRIENDS chart)

March: Polish and take the time to live with the pieces to feel secure. Do not underestimate the value of this month in securing memory, polishing the rough spots, and making the pieces the very best you can.

March group classes: Play entire pieces memorized.

March 1-23: "Dress Rehearsals": Perform your entire program at 2 separate occasions (family gatherings, music class at school, church, nursing home, etc.)

March 23: Get a good night's sleep, make sure your music is ready, your nails are clean and clipped short, and your Sunday best clothes are clean and ready to wear.

March 24: Do your best—be proud of your accomplishments!
